Listen to the Scientists

According to the CDC, NIH:

- In light of COVID-19, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and the National Institutes of Health are advising the public to refrain from marijuana use
- Marijuana use may increase risk for severe COVID-19 complications (CNN)

Social Injustice

- African Americans are arrested for pot at twice the rate as Caucasians in Colorado (CDPS, 2018)
- Less than 20% of the pot industry has minority ownership (Green Entrepreneur)
- In Colorado, there is 1 pot shop for every 42 people in communities of color (Denver Post, 2016)

Youth Use

- California had a <u>25%</u>
 <u>increase last year in youth</u>
 <u>using marijuana monthly</u>
 last year
- Nevada saw youth monthly use of <u>marijuana increase</u> <u>17%</u> last year
- Youth monthly use in legal states is more than 54% higher than non-legal states
